Holy Trinity Rewards

All children start the day on Bronze.

Holy Trinity
Champion – 5hps



They are removed from Bronze if after a verbal warning they are still not responding and doing the right thing or if they have deliberately hurt another child.

Gold – 3hps

Children can progress to silver, gold and HT champion during the day through showing good effort, achievement or acts of kindness.

Silver – 2hps

House points are awarded at the end of the day according to where they finish on the chart.

Bronze – 1hp

Children also have opportunities to earn House points by meeting other class expectations.

House points- Swap, Shop, Save

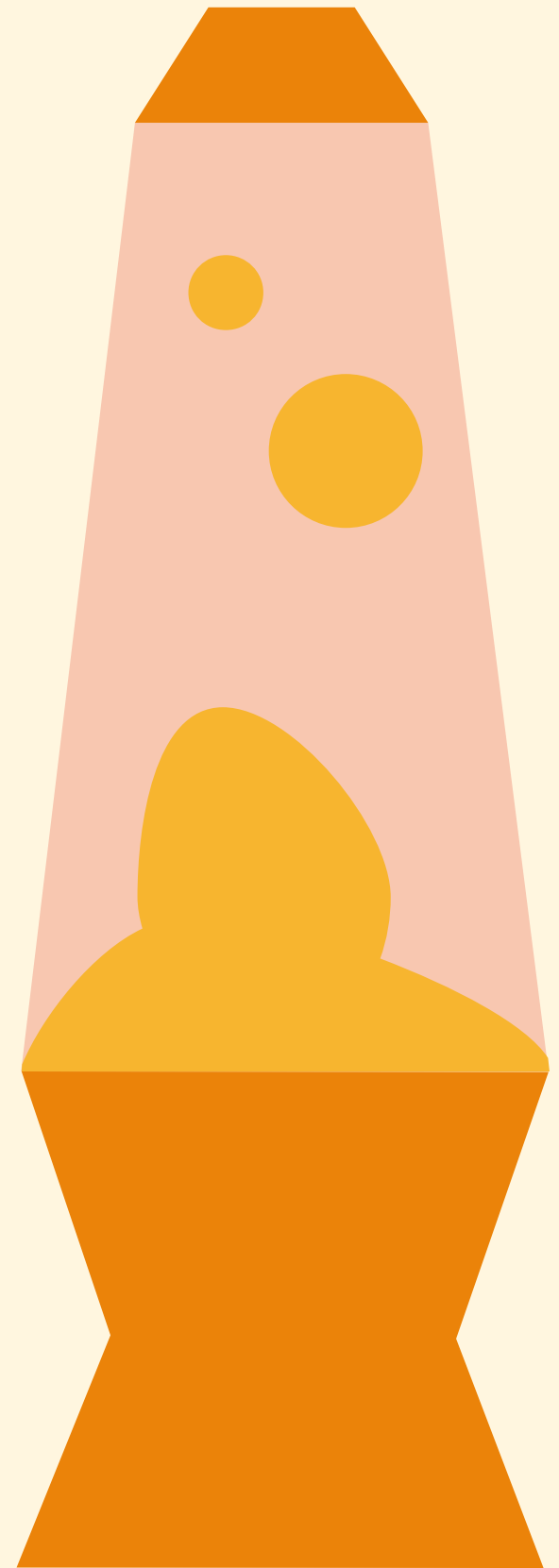


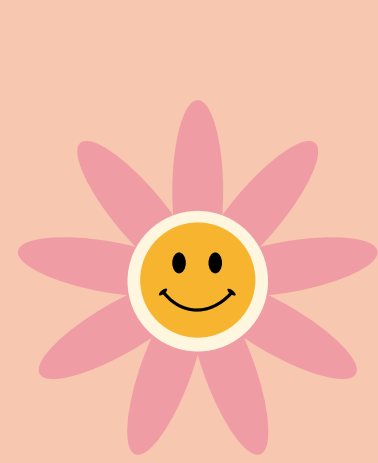
Reading



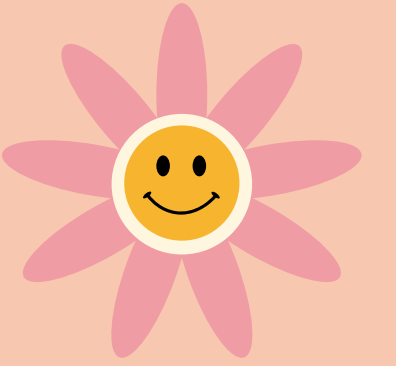
- They will read in groups in class 3x times per week.

- They will receive phonics lessons everyday

THIS IS UPDATE DAILY SO THAT THE CHILDREN ARE PREPARED FOR THE DAY.

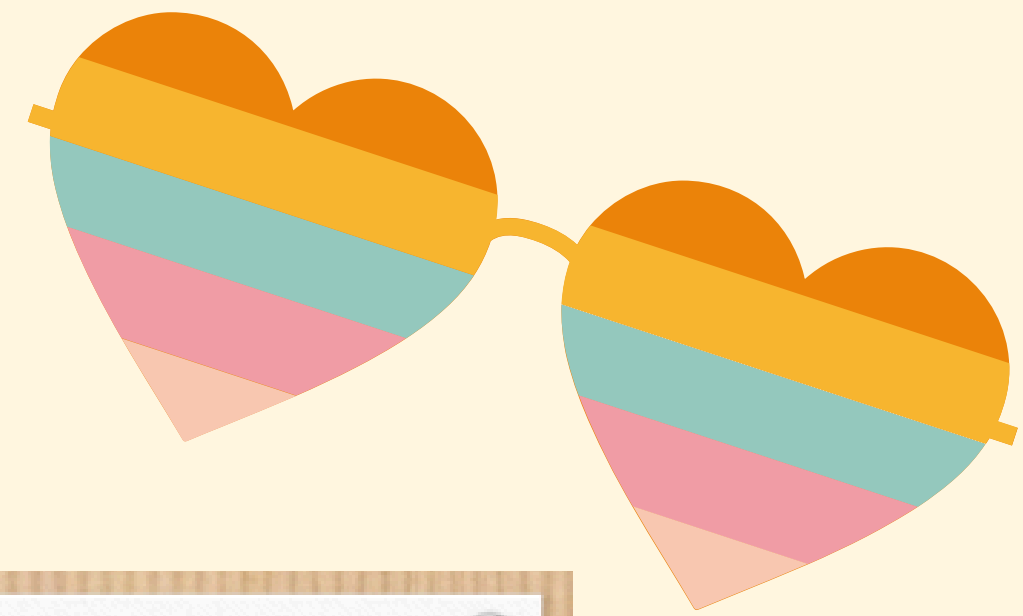

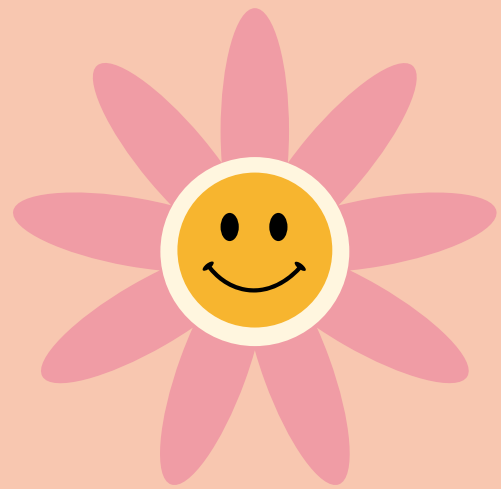

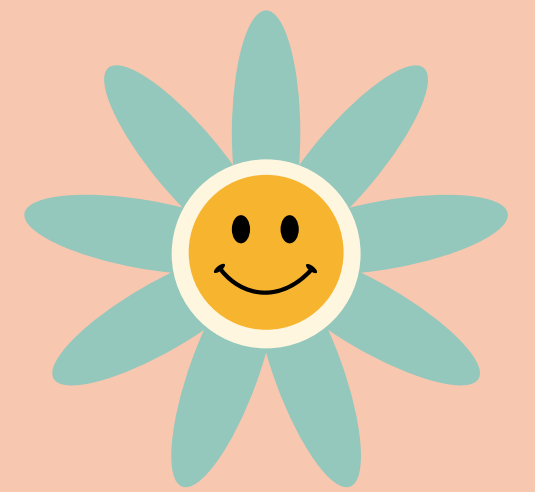
