Year 1 Newsletter

We are learning about...

ENGLISH/PHONICS

In term 3 we will be sharing the book 'A Winters Sleep' about a child and their grandparent exploring the seasons in their local woodland and garden.

We will be moving through the phonics program, with split digraphs, and new ways of using familiar sounds.

MATHS

In term 3 we will be moving onto larger numbers, working within 20. We will be practising the skills we have learned in terms 1 & 2 for addition and subtraction and will build on number bond knowledge.



PROJECT

In project this term we will be thinking about toys in history. What toys do we love? What did our parents and grandparents play with? And how toys have changed through the years.

In science, we will be learning about everyday materials- naming objects and identifying what they are made from, exploring why certain materials are suitable for different purposes, and describing their properties. We will also be developing our scientific skills by sorting and grouping materials, making predictions, carrying out simple tests, and using our observations to answer questions.

We will also be completing art and DT work, where will be making 3D paper-based art using techniques such as rolling, folding and scrunching paper.
