P.E.

- In term 1 - PE and Woodland School will be on Thursday afternoon.
- Please make sure that your child comes to school dressed in the correct kit and has a water bottle. Lessons will take place outside weather permitting so a coat will be required.

Swimming - Tuesday

- Please make sure that your child comes to school dressed in their PE kit for swimming and brings the required swimming kit (letters will be sent out) in a bag and your child has a jumper/cardigan/fleece AND a coat.

Water and Snacks

- It is very important for your child to have a water bottle with them in school.
- Please make sure it is ONLY water that is being sent into school in a clearly labelled bottle (name and class number)
- No snacks are provided in key stage 2. You can give your child a healthy snack for break time which they can eat on the playground.

Equipment

The children do have access to these items in school but we know that some like to bring in their own equipment. If so, these are the items that we use the most, in order to enable learning.

- **A pencil case with:**

A pencil, a non-bendy ruler, pencil sharpener with lid, colouring pencils, glue (pritt stick), whiteboard pen (any colour), colouring pens if they wish.



General Everyday Homework

- It is really important that you listen to your child read everyday! We expect your child to read at least 4 times a week. Contact books are provided for you to jot down when you have spent time listening to and discussing the story with your child. They can then quiz on their finished books using Accelerated Reader and their individual logins (links on class website page).
- We will be continuing our work with the 3/4 and 5/6 spellings. Your child will be given the opportunity to learn these through activities in the classroom. Lists have been sent home for pupils to continue to practise at home.
- TTRS - multiplication tables are at the epicentre of all our maths - please ensure your child is accessing TTRS or some other method of multiplication tables practice everyday!

Homework

- All pupils will be given individual books to work through a section each week.
- We will begin with the year 5 booklets up until the end of term 2 and then term 3 onwards the year 6 books will be provided to support their knowledge and understanding.
- Homework will be set on a Friday and will need to be returned on a Wednesday.
This gives the children plenty of time to ask for support from the class adults before the due date.
