

Number Activities

- Use the number line to count to 20.
- Number recognition - show your child a number and ask them to read it.
- Number recognition - spread out the numbers on the table, call out a number for your child to find.
- Number sequencing - give your child the cards and ask them to put them in the correct order from 0 to 20.
- Count out objects in the home to match each number. E.g 2 teddies, 15 pens.
- Missing number - lay out the numbers in order from 0 - 20. Take away a number and ask your child which number is missing. Practise writing that number.
- Practise tracing the numbers
- Practise writing the numbers in order.
- Have a number morning. Choose a number and have a competition to see who can find the most on the way to school - doors, car number plates, advertisements etc.
- Count anything and play games that involve counting and reading numbers.
- Use the number line to find 1 more and 1 less than any number to 20.
- Play snakes and ladders
- Match numbers to pictures
