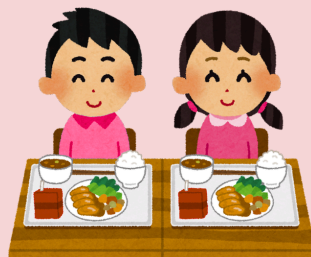

Healthy Lunch Box

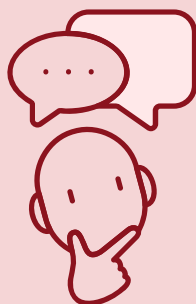

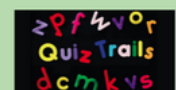
