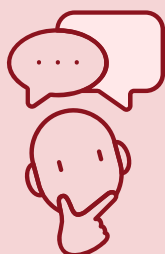

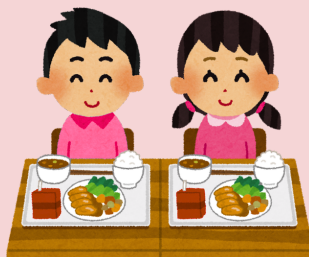

If your child would like to have school a school meal on this day, they will need to order it in the morning when the lunch register is taken.

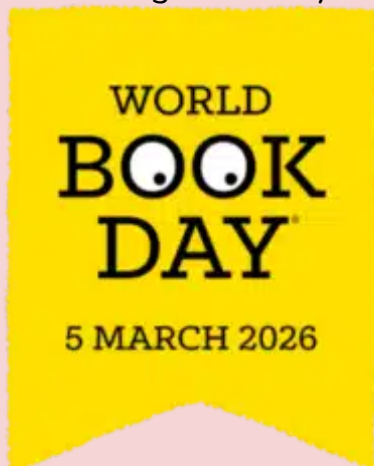

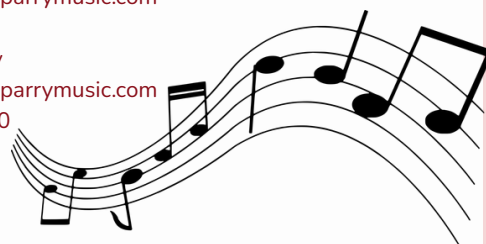
ANDREW PARRY MUSIC
