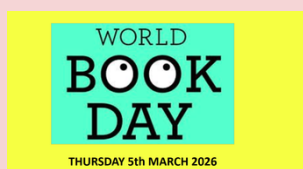
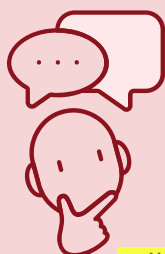

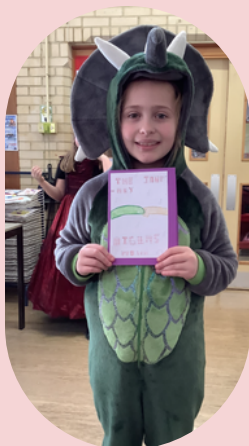


ENRICHMENT

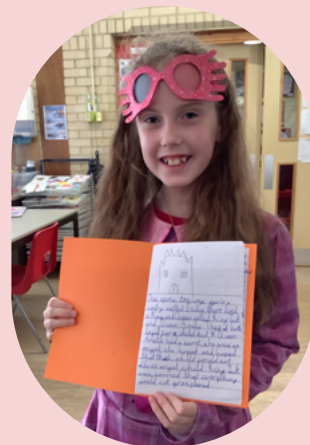

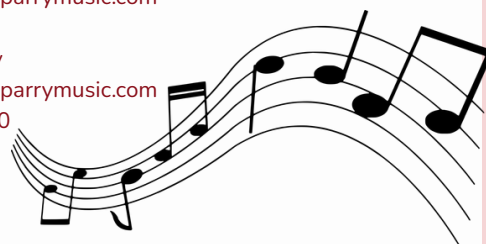
ANDREW PARRY MUSIC
