If your pay for your child's meals please use your ParentPay account in the usual way. The cost of a school meal is £3.05.





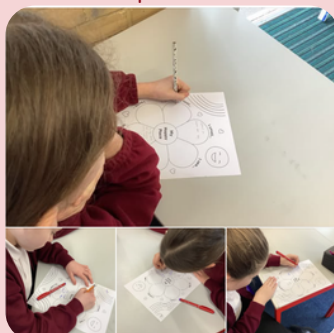

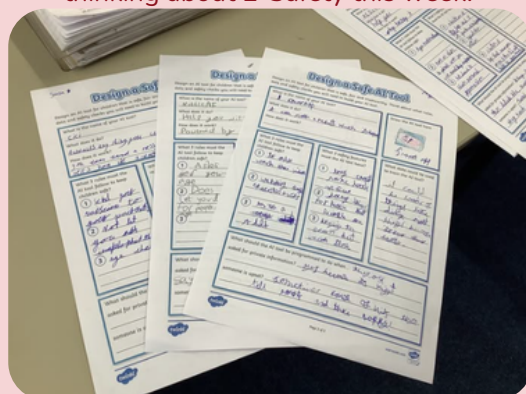

Children in Osprey Class thought about their happy place

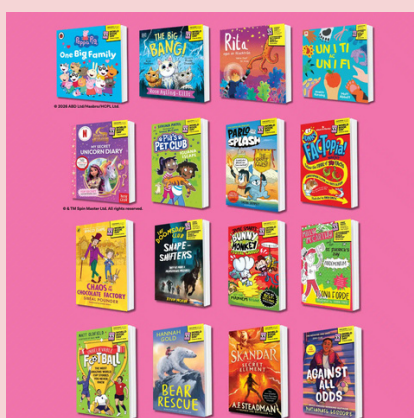
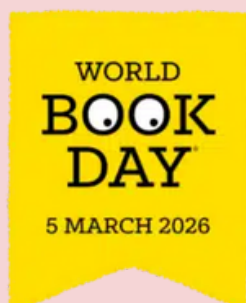


Osprey Class designed a safe AI tool thinking about E-Safety this week.
