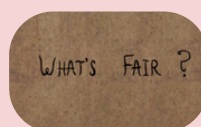

If you can spare some time to help out in anyway, please leave your name at the school office.



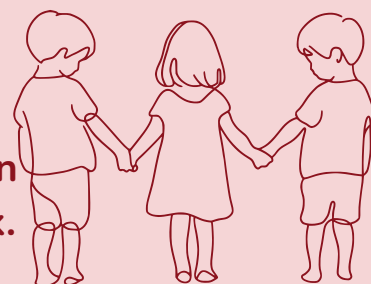
