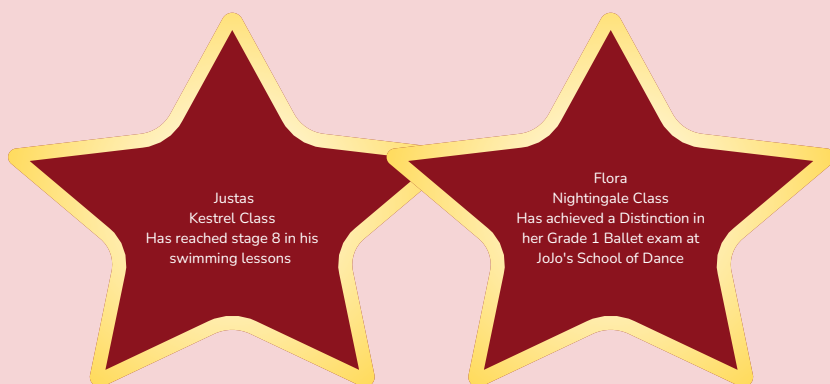

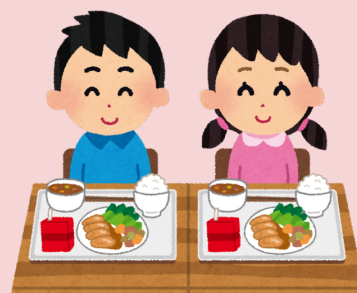

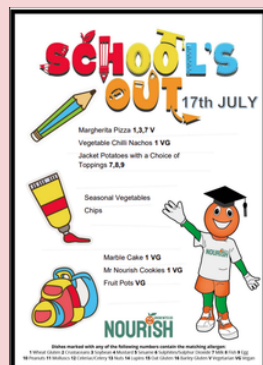
Meal Prices

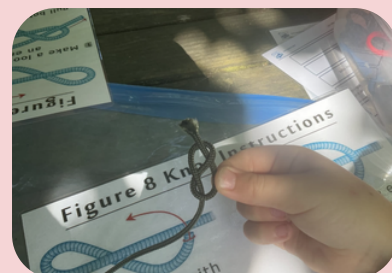


Nightingale class had a music lesson this afternoon using the glockenspiels
