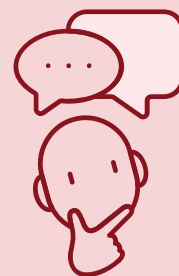
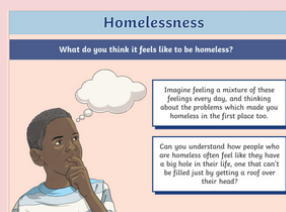

Parent Consultations .

The Arbor online booking system will be open from Monday 6th October from 9.00am

This will be an opportunity for you to meet your child's teacher to see how they have settled in at school and for you to ask any questions you may have.

- Make one appointment on either Tuesday OR Thursday.

You do not need to make an appointment for both evenings

- Appointments can be made online via Arbor. Log to your Arbor app (or online at the Arbor Parent Portal.

The Parent Portal is the version of Arbor accessible to parents on a laptop or computer)

- On your child's profile you will find a section called Parent Engagement which show the two days. You may have to scroll down the page to find this section.

- Click on which day you would like to attend a meeting and another screen will appear.

- There will be a green box called Schedule Meeting. Click on this box.

- On the next screen you can book a time slot.

- Click on the green box and you will have a list of times that the teacher is available.

- Choose your appointment time and click on the green box to book that slot.

- Return to your child's profile page and under Parental Engagement it will show the time and day you have booked.

Miss Cygan (EYFS/KS1 Lead) will be available at both Parents Evenings if you want to discuss anything further after you have spoken to your child's teacher. No appointment is required.

Year 6 children – if you have a query about your child's secondary school transfer please make an appointment with your child's teacher.

Mrs Douglas (KS2 Lead) will be available at both Parents Evenings if you want to discuss anything further about secondary school transfer after you have spoken to your child's teacher. No appointment is required.

Mrs McGuirk (SENCO) will be available at both Parents Evenings by appointment only. If you want to make an appointment, please come to the school office. Appointments cannot be made online.

Hive Children – please come to the school office to make your appointment. Appointments cannot be made online.

Parent Governor Vacancy.

The school has a vacancy for parents to sit on the Governing Body, alongside other parents, school staff, members of the public and the Vicar of St John's Church.

The Governing Body acts as a "critical friend" to the school with guidance from the Senior Leadership Team of the school although the Head Teacher is responsible for making day-to-day decisions about the running of the school.

Governors are involved in deciding school policies, allocating the school's budget and appointing senior staff. No special qualifications, or experience are needed and the most important thing is to have a keen interest in the school and be prepared to play an active part in the governing body's work. 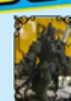
