It has been lovely to welcome our new reception children in, lots of smiling faces ready to start this exciting stage of their education.

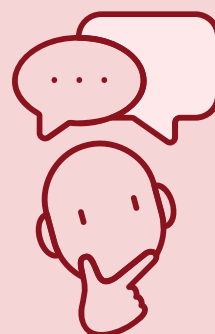
We value the strong partnership between home and school, and we encourage open communication throughout the year. Together, we can make this year a successful and memorable one for all our pupils.

Pupils from years R-6 and The Hive will be rewarded with golden tokens to exchange for books from the vending machine in the following ways:

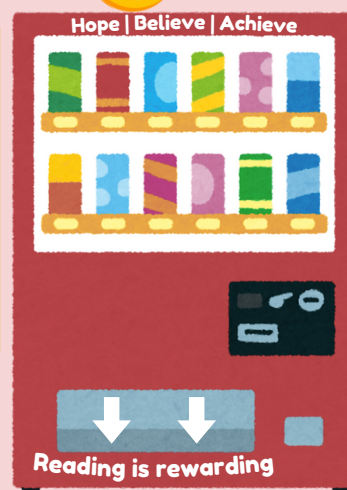
Years R-6 and The Hive

Years 2-6

- Years 2-6 regularly quizzing on books read by using their Accelerated Reader login or myON (please see your child's class teacher or Miss Wall for further details).
- Years 2-6, each term if you are one of the top three pupils who have quizzed on the most books you have read in your ZPD range.
- Years 2-6 each term, if you have scored 100% in all your quizzes (minimum of three) in your ZPD reading book range.

TTRS & Numbots



Pupils achieve better in math if they have a good recall of number facts and multiplication tables.

At HTSJ each pupil has a login for **Numbots** and **Times Tables Rock Stars** so they can practice at home through online math games which make math fun and engaging.

Please try to encourage your child to play Numbots (years R to 2) or TTRS (years 3 -6) at home.

As little as **3 minutes per day** is all that is needed to see an improvement.
