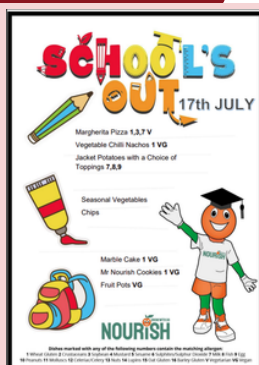

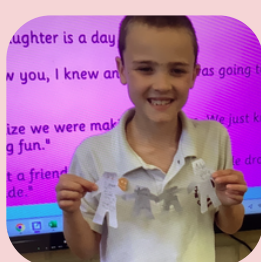
To recognise their achievement, each child has received a special certificate from Young Writers, which they can display proudly as a reminder of their success.
