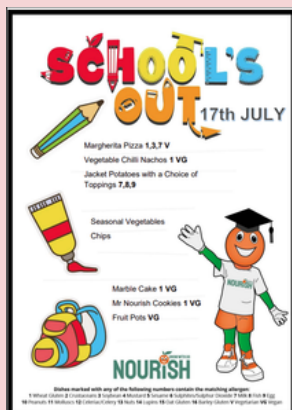



Shoe Box Appeal

Year Four - Times Tables

As we head into the half-term break, we'd like to gently remind families of the importance of keeping multiplication tables fresh in children's minds.

Regular practice—even just a few minutes a day—helps pupils keep their skills sharp and boosts their confidence ahead of the upcoming multiplication check.

Multiplication facts are a fundamental building block for so much of the maths learning that follows in Years 5 and 6.

Strong recall supports everything from fractions to long multiplication, division, and problem-solving. A little practice now makes a big difference later.
