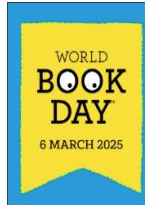

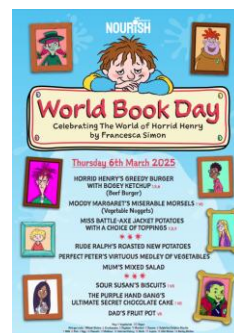


POTATO CHARACTER COMPETITION!
