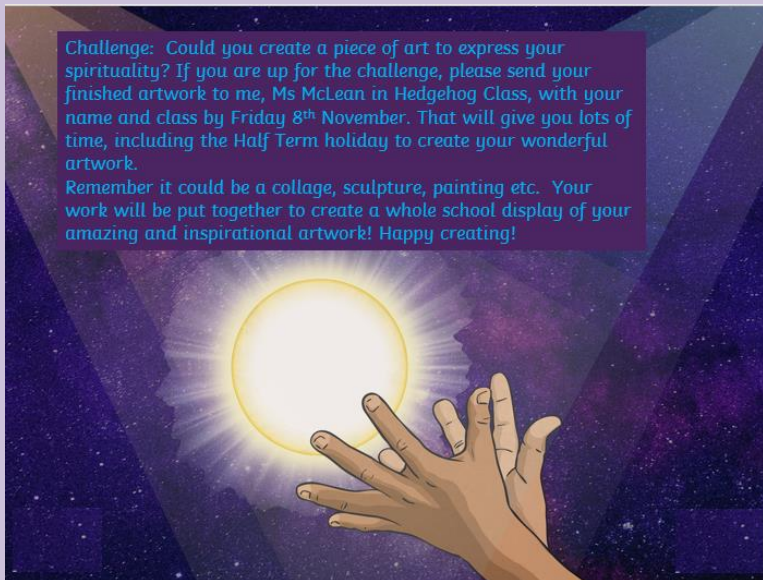

This term we explored spirituality and art during collective worship with Mrs. McLean. She would like to remind you that she set children the challenge of creating their own piece of art to express their spirituality.

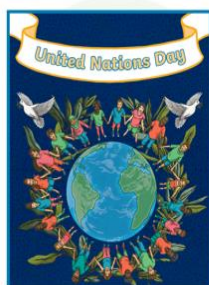
