ENRICHMENT



Nightingale class have been designing their own shell structures to create an effective helmet. We have started the process of creating our own today using papier-mâché.



Inspired by the narrative poem 'The Highwayman' Red Kite class created their own highwayman/woman character and wrote detailed descriptions about them. These highway thieves were notorious in their time and eagerly sought after; with rewards for anyone who aided in their arrest.

To enhance our work, we tea-stained some paper to give it an authentic, historical feel before writing our descriptions upon it. All the drawings are pencil sketches of imagined own characters.
