

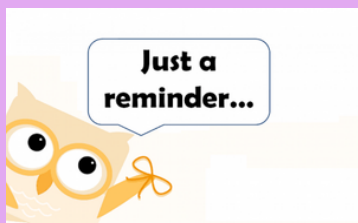

We are looking forward to working with you all in Year 2. We have an exciting year planned, where we will learn all about animals and their habitats, plant growth, our wonderful world, what a monarch is and so much more!

ENGLISH

This term we will be reading the book 'Orion and the Dark'. This beautifully illustrated story explores fears and feelings in a thoughtful and engaging way. Through the book, the children will develop their vocabulary and use it to support a range of writing activities, building towards this term's two extended writing outcomes: a recount (a diary entry) and a free verse poem.

MATHS

We begin by practising numbers to 100, recognising tens and ones, partitioning and writing numbers to 100 in words. We will represent this using a part whole model, base 10 and bar models. As the term progresses we explore using number lines to 100 and practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.
