

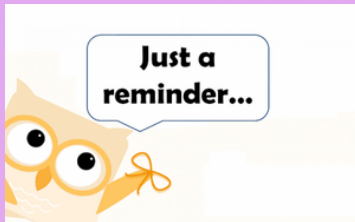

ENGLISH
