

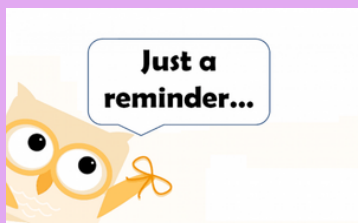

- Full school uniform to be worn daily, all named and labelled. See the school website for the uniform list.

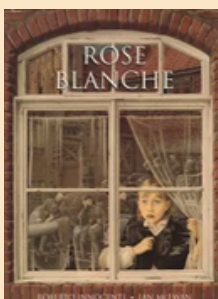
