

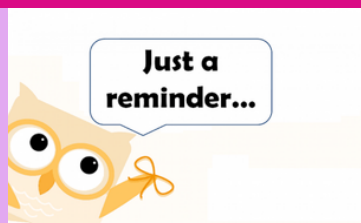

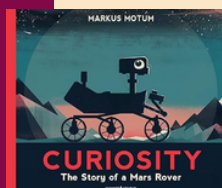
- P.E will be on Tuesday morning in term 1 (this might change throughout the year. We will keep you informed).

### ENGLISH
